

PARISH HELP WITH SOUTH SUBURBAN PADS FAMILY SHELTER

Just one more reminder about the PADS Family Shelter at St. Lawrence O'Toole..... We've been invited to join many other local communities of worship in staffing the shelter just one night a month, probably a Wednesday beginning in December. From 12 to 15 volunteers are needed to work the four shifts, with some shifts needing only two or three volunteers. The hours are: 6:00pm to 11:00pm; 10:45pm to 3:00am; 2:45 to 7:00am; and 5:00 to 7:00am. Each shift has different responsibilities, with those in the wee hours of the morning simply ensuring that all the guests are sleeping soundly. No one is asked to volunteer for more than one shift, and again, this is only once a month for St. Joseph parishioners.
